The Outstanding Artist Piano Competition may serve as a positive initial step for students wanting to compete in the MTNA Performance Competitions in future years.

General Rules:

- Decisions of competition judges are final.
- A first-place winner may not participate in the same competition category again.
- Competition performances are open to the public.
- Audio or video recording and photography of the competitions are strongly discouraged.

Entrant Information:

- An entrant must be a resident of Washington State.
- All entry fees are nonrefundable.
- Competition financial obligations are the responsibility of the entrant and teacher.
- Entry deadline is September 14, 2022

WSMTA Member Teachers:

- Current membership dues for MTNA and WSMTA must be paid before entering students.
- **A teacher may not enter the same student in both WSMTA OAPC and MTNA Performance Competition in the same year.**
- Teacher entry fees: \$20.00 per student entered. Member Competition fees must be paid on or before September 14, 2022.

WSMTA Non-member Teachers:

- Non-members have the option of becoming a member of MTNA and WSMTA or paying a Teacher Entry Fee of \$150.00 for first student and \$20.00 for each additional student. Non-member Competition fees must be paid on or before September 14, 2022.
- Non-members must register using a paper form, available on the WSMTA website.

Student Fees:

- **Junior Division:** Age: 11-14 as of January 1, 2023
 - Entry Fee: \$100.00
 - Maximum performance time: twenty (20) minutes.
- **Senior Division:** Age: 15-18 as of January 1, 2023
 - Entry Fee: \$120.00
 - Maximum performance time: twenty-five (25) minutes



Repertoire Requirements:

- Each program must contain stylistically varied compositions from at least two contrasting style periods.
- Memorization is required for all repertoire.
- Concerto performances are not permitted.
- Compositions for prepared piano are not permitted.
- Transcriptions are allowed.

Competition Music:

- All entrants must abide by the federal Copyright Law. Photocopies are strongly discouraged.
- Entrants must provide the judges with one score for each work listed on the application form.
- Measures must be numbered at the beginning of each system.
- Students must perform the repertoire listed on the original application.
- Teachers should verify that all repertoire listings are correct before submission of the application.
- No changes in repertoire are allowed.
- The time you submit will be the time allowed and there can be no changes or additions once the application is submitted.

Competition Performance Procedures:

- No minimum time limit.
- Programmed music may exceed maximum time limit.
- Performance will be stopped when stated or maximum time is reached (it does not affect results).
- Student chooses first selection; judges determine remaining order of performance.

Competition Agreement:

It is the responsibility of the **teacher, entrant and parent or guardian** to abide by all rules and regulations for the WSMTA Outstanding Artist Piano Competition. Failure to meet this responsibility will result in the disqualification of the entrant.
